4. House / Shelter

- Am I planning for long-term stability?

5. Transportation

- Is my transportation reliable and maintained?
- Can I reach the places I need without stress?

6. Financial Independence

- Did I make wise spending choices today?
- Am I moving toward debt freedom and savings?

7. Purpose / Calling

- Am I using my God-given gifts?
- Am I aligned with the mission God has for me?

8. Work / Service

- Did my work bring value to others today?
- Am I balancing earning with serving?

9. Community

- Did I connect with or encourage someone today?

10. Education / Growth

- Did I learn something new or build wisdom?
- Am I investing in skills for my future?

11. Time

- Did I guard time for God, family, and rest?
- Am I saying “yes” only to what matters?

12. Peace of Mind

- Did I release stress and practice gratitude?
- Did I find joy in the small blessings today?

13. Legacy

- Am I planting seeds that will outlast me?
- Will my family and community remember faith, love, and impact?
